Course Description

This course provides a review of all aspects of diagnostic radiology. Specific sessions cover most organ-based and procedure-based sections of radiology, such as vascular and interventional radiology, neuroradiology, chest radiology, gastrointestinal radiology, cardiac radiology, pediatric radiology, ultrasonography, genitourinary radiology, nuclear medicine, musculoskeletal radiology and breast imaging. The course will review the imaging features of the major disease entities in each of these sections. These lectures will be given during the morning and afternoon sessions. Evening sessions will provide interactive teaching file case-based review of the days lectures, using innovative audience response system technology. During these casebased evening interactive sessions, stress will be given to development and presentation of appropriate differential diagnoses and imaging workups for each case.
